The Paden City Common Council met in special session on Tuesday, April 21, 2026 at 6:00 P M. in the council chambers of the municipal building with Mayor Clyde Hochstrasser presiding.

The following members of council were present: Shawna Kendle, Mike Turner, Linda Duke, Ken Stead, Don Dillaman, Jon Baker. Also present were Mayor Clyde Hochstrasser, Recorder Penny Baker, and Superintendent Josh Billiter.

LAY THE LEVY: The purpose of the meeting is to lay the levy of the property tax rates for the next fiscal year, 2026-2027, to hear and consider any objections and to officially adopt the levy rates for property taxation. The budget was adopted by City Council on March 16, 2026 and was published in the local newspaper on March 25, 2026 and April 1, 2026. No citizens were present and no objections were heard. Motion by Jon Baker, second by Shawna Kendle to adopt the levy rates. All in favor.

Budget revisions for 2025-2026: General Fund

Motion by Shawna Kendle, second by Jon Baker to move \$25,000 from 699 Contingencies to 715 Fire Hydrants and to move \$25,000 from 699 Contingencies to 900 Park, all in favor.

Motion by Mike Turner, second by Linda Duke for the Park money to be earmarked for salaries and utilities only, all in favor.
